"So the children of Joseph, Manasseh and Ephraim, took their inheritance."

- Jospeh was given a double portion.

- 1 Chronicles 5:1 Now we come to the sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel. For Reuben was the eldest, but because he polluted his father's couch [with Bilhah his father's concubine] his birthright was given to the sons of Joseph [favourite] son of Israel; so the genealogy is not to be reckoned according to the birthright.

- Joseph is well blessed/rewarded. Jospeh's faithfulness and testimony leave a precious reminder in his legacy. When the people consider their history and heritage and look at these two tribes they will be reminded of Joseph's faithfulness and what God did through Joesph for their fathers.

- They left a part undone. They left the enemy with a foothold in the land.

- The consequences of this would cause so much suffering in the future... For generations. Their children would suffer because of this lack of faith.

- We really do cause ourselves and others so much pain and loss because we are not thorough with our sin/flesh. If we have a conviction then we should obey quickly and completely!
